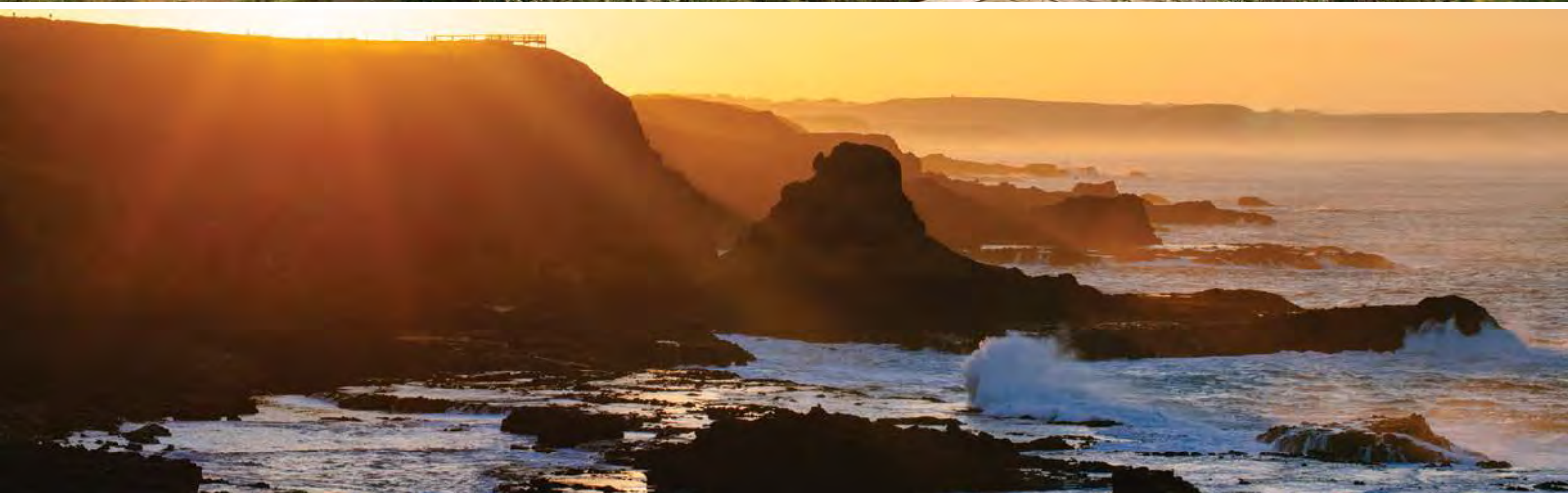

Each night at sunset, watch the smallest penguins in the world as they march up the beach to their burrows in this amazing ancient ritual. The nightly Penguin Parade allows visitors the chance to see this spectacular natural phenomenon from a range of exclusive viewing options. Phillip Island boasts unique experiences, including; nature and wildlife, interactive and fun, wild and adventurous.



With a host of accommodation choices your stay on this compact island you will enjoy local hospitality when dining at venues in seaside villages, enriching your Island adventure. You can explore with your own self-drive program or arrive and join an accredited local tour operator who will help you discover this compact Island and surrounds secrets.

Come face to face with koalas from treetop boardwalks, stroll through cottage gardens, experience daily farming activities and enjoy drifting amongst thousands of playful seals on a cruise to Seal Rocks – the world's largest Australian Fur Seal colony. Experience wildlife encounters with Australian fauna of all types at leading wildlife parks. Phillip Island is home to some of Victoria's most stunning coastal scenery. Boasting miles of spectacular walks, secluded beaches and bays, internationally-renowned wetlands and nationally recognised surfing reserves. Visitors can discover themselves or take a scenic helicopter flight over it all.

For the adventurous, embark on a kayaking, surfing, snorkelling or cycling experience with local operators.

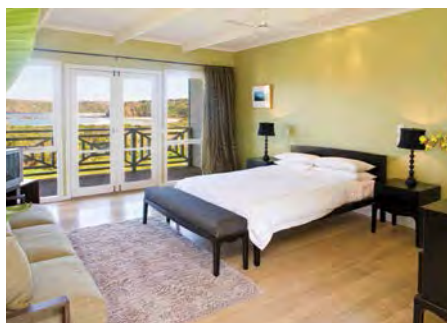


ADVENTURE ISLAND

Choose from beachfront general viewing stands, premium areas including Penguins Plus and Underground and a range of intimate eco-accredited tours.

Phillip Island Nature Parks is a not-for-profit, self-funded conservation and sustainable tourism organisation that protects 25% of Phillip Island including the world's largest Little Penguin population. PHILLIP ISLAND NATURE PARKS – KOALA RESERVE

Get close to koalas in their natural habitat in one of Phillip Island's last remnant woodland reserves at the Koala Conservation Reserve.

Walk along the treetop boardwalks and look out for the youngest resident koala born at the Koala Conservation Reserve in late 2019. While here, keep an eye out for wallabies, echidnas and a vast array of colourful birds too.

Get to know the history of koala conservation on Phillip Island in the interactive museum and exhibition space.

Wander through the beautiful gardens and historic buildings set against the stunning backdrop of Western Port Bay at Churchill Island.

Try your hand at living off the land and get involved in the daily farm activities of cow milking, sheep shearing, whip cracking and working dog demonstration.

Watch out for clues of Churchill Island's newest night-time wanderer on the tracks and trails. Considered extinct on mainland Australia, the Eastern Barred Bandicoot was introduced in 2015 is now thriving with the help of Nature Parks conservation rangers.

MOONLIT SANCTUARY WILDLIFE CONSERVATION PARK

Fantastic opportunities to get close to Australian native animals at this award-winning wildlife conservation park.

Explore 10 hectares of bushland, meeting endangered species, feeding kangaroos and wallabies, petting koalas and enjoying hands-on encounters with friendly birds, wombats, pythons and dingoes. Moonlit Sanctuary is home to over 70 Australian species. Find out about endangered species or enjoy a magical evening wildlife tour.

WARROOK FARM

Warrook is living history, a full working farm over 100 years old. Specially tailored tours showcase the history of the farm, its wildlife, homestead and gardens. The farm tour includes hands-on experiences and demonstrations: cow milking, petting pens, whip cracking, sheep dog demonstrations and sheep shearing. The fauna park enables visitors to get close to Australian and other animals and birdlife, get up close to the koalas, feed the kangaroos and wombat, view geese and ducks on the scenic dam.

Visitors can enjoy a country roast lunch in the homestead restaurant or select from the delicious menu in the cafe. Spit Lamb roasts are popular with groups, billy tea and damper are optional extras with the farm tour. Halal meals are also available.

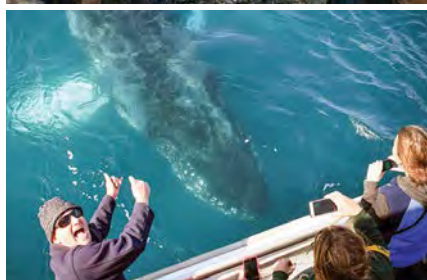

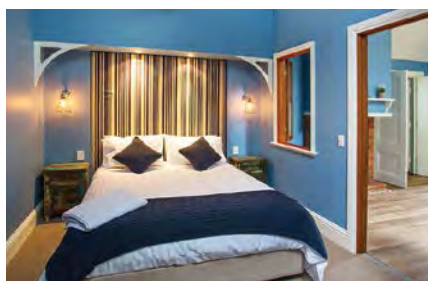

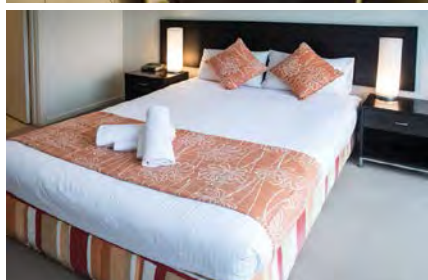
